As part of MSU Extension and the Health and Nutrition Institute, this position provides leadership and educational programming expertise in Disease Prevention and Management and Community Behavioral Health. This position assesses community health needs; implements evidence-based programs; designs and evaluates educational programming based on applied research and program evaluation methods; ensures dissemination of research-based information through various methods, including multi-media, presentations and written articles; and, serves as an informational resource for Extension personnel and clientele. Community behavior health includes interdisciplinary perspectives to deal with system changes, policies, and environmental changes of communities and institutions and includes being responsive to mental health and substance abuse prevention across the state and promoting behavioral health literacy within Extension and across Michigan communities.
