This position assesses community health needs; designs, implements and evaluates educational programming based on applied research and program evaluation methods; ensures dissemination of research-based information through various methods, including multi-media, presentations and written articles; and, serves as an informational resource for Extension personnel and clientele. This position implements evidence-based programs including National Diabetes Prevention Program, Dining with Diabetes, A Matter of Balance, and Chronic Disease Self-Management Program. This position is based out of the MSU Extension Wayne County Office—Focus Hope, and will provide coverage for the counties included in MSU Extension administrative District 11, including Wayne, Oakland and Macomb.
