This position assesses community food safety needs; implements evidence-based programs; designs and evaluates educational programming based on applied research and program evaluation methods; ensures dissemination of research-based information through various methods, including multi-media, presentations and written articles; and, serves as an information resource for Extension personnel and clientele. This position will be based out of the MSU Extension office located in Muskegon.
