Further, you may collaborate with Detroit Kitchen Connect, Food Lab, Detroit Food and Ag Network, MI Works! Association, and other local and regional food and agricultural entities. You will participate in the planning and implementation of statewide and Product Center events like the Making It In Michigan Conference and Trade Show.

There will be space available for this position to work from the Detroit Economic Growth offices with occasional time spent at Eastern Market of Detroit.
